Finally the program ended, leaving behind sweet memories that will be cherished lifelong.

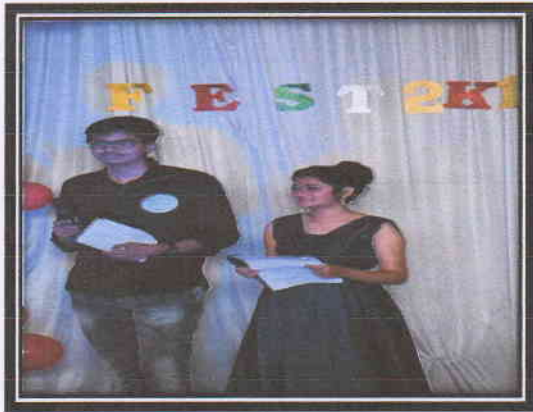

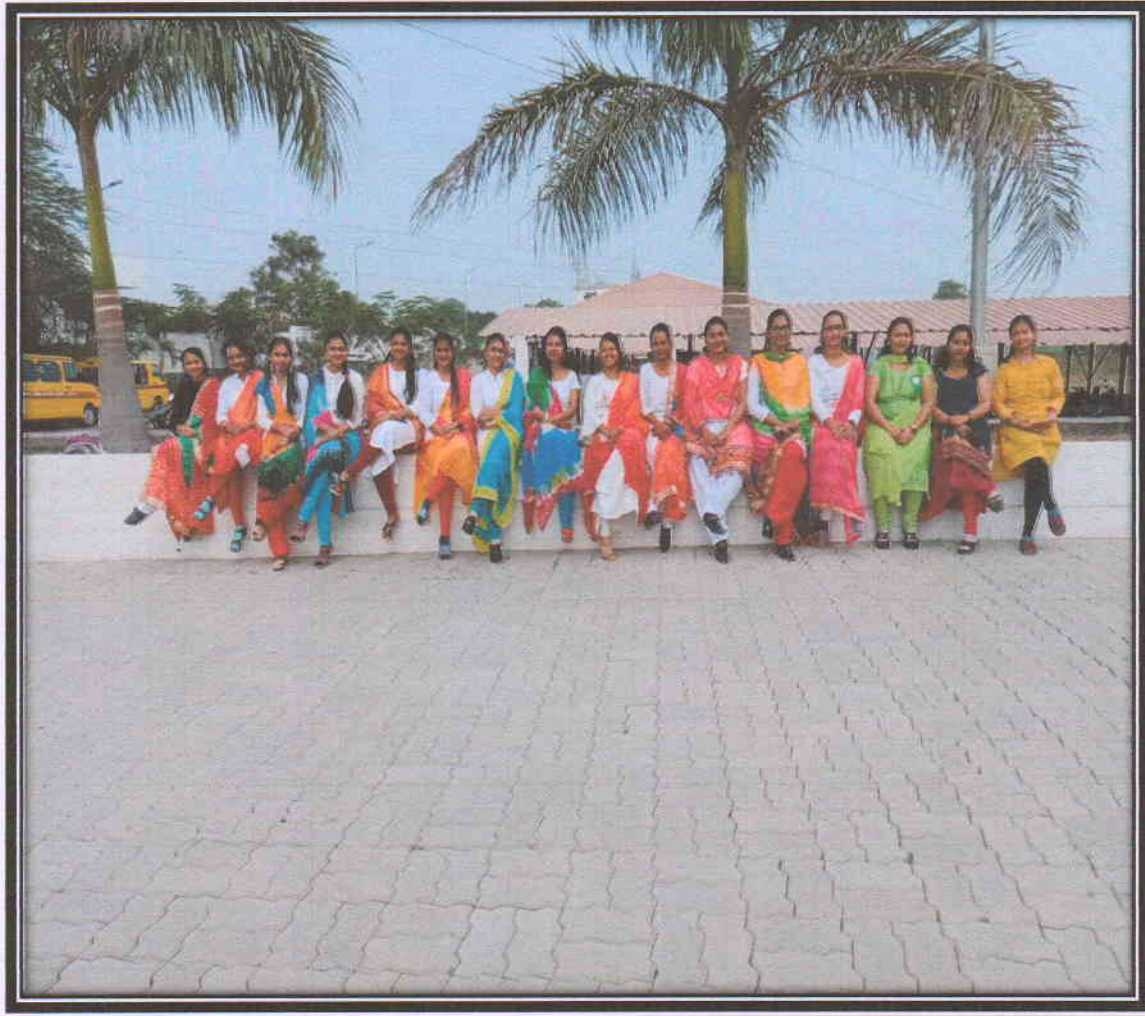
